

## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY CONTROLLED SCHOOLS

- 1) The name of the school is Compton Church of England Primary School, Plymouth.
- 2) The school is a voluntary controlled school.
- 3) The name of the governing body is 'The governing board of Compton Church of England Primary School, Plymouth'.
- 4) The governing body shall consist of:
  - a) 2 Parent Governors;
  - b) 1 LA Governor;
  - c) 1 Staff Governor;
  - d) 1 Headteacher;
  - e) 6 Co-Opted Governors;
  - f) 2 Foundation Governors (one of whom shall be Ex-officio).
- 5) Total number of governors 13.
- 6) Foundation governors shall be appointed by Exeter Diocesan Board of Education.
- 7) (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:  
The Principle Officiating Minister.  
  
(b) The Archdeacon of Plymouth shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or if there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his/her governorship exists.
- 8) Exeter Diocesan Board of Education shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor, in consultation with the Archdeacon named in 7 (b) above.
- 9) The school was founded by Trust Deed.
- 10) Ethos statement:

This is a Church of England school in the Diocese of Exeter.

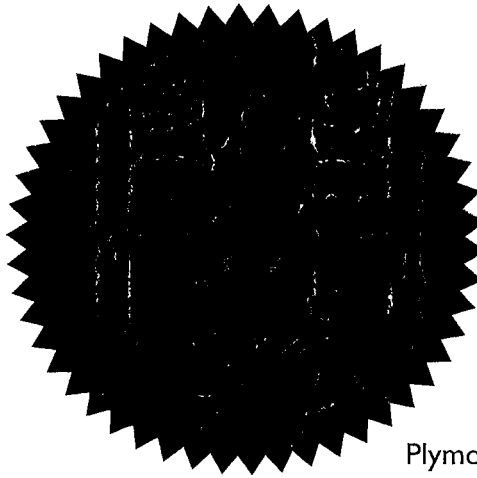
Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles and practice of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church in the parish and the diocese.

- 11) This instrument of government comes into effect 21 January 2020.
