Compton Colour Run

We're excited to announce our summer family event, taking place on Saturday 15th June between 1-4pm on the school field. It will be our first ever Compton Colour Run and it promises to be a huge amount of fun! Please note, this replaces the Summer Fair this year.

What's a Colour Run?

Inspired by the Holi festival - where coloured powder is thrown in celebration – the Colour Run will involve children racing round the school track with their friends and classmates; climbing over, crawling under, and dodging round obstacles; all while explosions of coloured powder are thrown around them. The aim is to get as colourful as possible!

With Devon & Somerset Fire & Rescue Service on hand to help blast the children with water to really help that powder stick, and a hay bale mountain to clamber and car tyre obstacles the leap through, the school field will be transformed for the day. Your children won't want to miss it.

Volunteers depending, we also plan to have a bar, snacks, candy floss... and even a bubble tea stall! Come and make a day of it as a family.

How do I get a ticket?

Tickets are on sale now in ParentPay. It is £5 per child taking part – and to make sure we can keep the races safe and well organised, we will only invite Compton pupils to get involved. Although we are considering adult/family races to finish up the day... and we're keen to hold a race for the teachers!

We'll send you full instructions about the event much nearer the time, including the schedule for the timed Colour Run sessions, what to wear and what to bring. The powder we will use is cornstarch-based – all children taking part will have to wear goggles or sunglasses to prevent it from getting in their eyes. We are selling Colour Run kids' neon sunglasses for £3 alongside tickets if you'd like to purchase and receive them on the day.

How can I help?

As ever, we can only run this event if we have sufficient volunteers, so if you can help, we'd appreciate it. If you normally help at the Summer Fair, this event is replacing the traditional fair, so please put your name down!
