When should my child return to school?

Chickenpox

at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over

Whooping Cough

48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Scabies

after the first treatment

Measles

4 days after the rash first appeared

Diarrhoea and Vomiting

48 hours after their last episode

Cold and flu

they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend

The following require no time off school but make sure your school or nursery know about them

Headlice, Conjunctivitis
Tonsillitis, Glandular Fever
Slapped Cheek, Threadworm

Scarlet Fever

24 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Impetigo

their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics

Mumps

5 days after the swelling started

Please remember this is a guide and if you feel your child is not well enough to attend to school please use your own judgement as a parent

Do you work in a STEM related career?

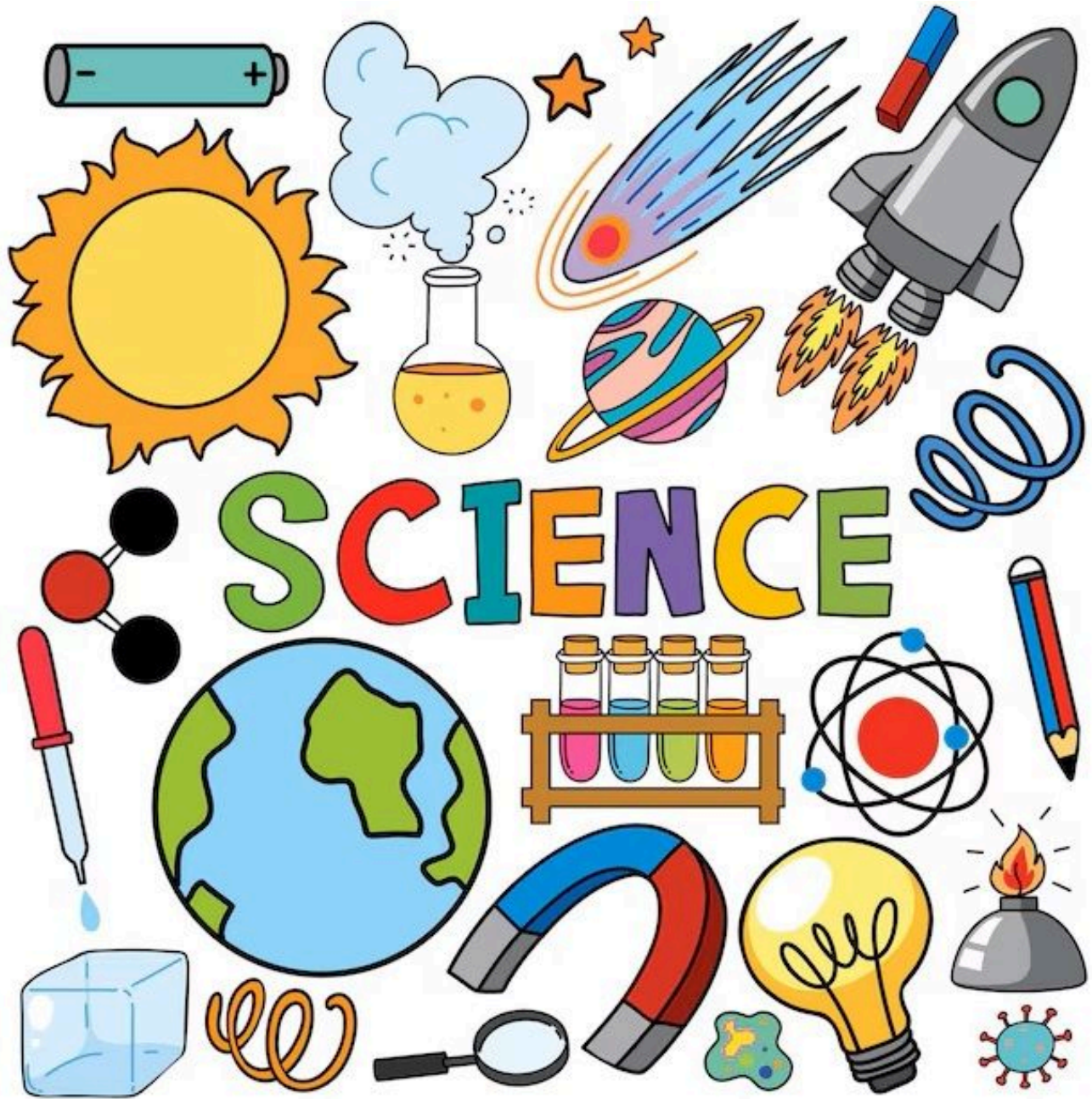

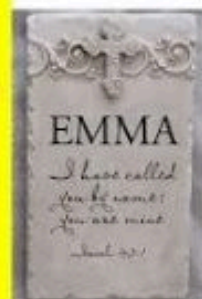

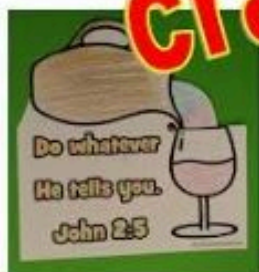
