A special thank you goes to one of our fabulous parents who kindly installed an outside tap, a brilliant addition that will make watering plants and outdoor activities so much easier.

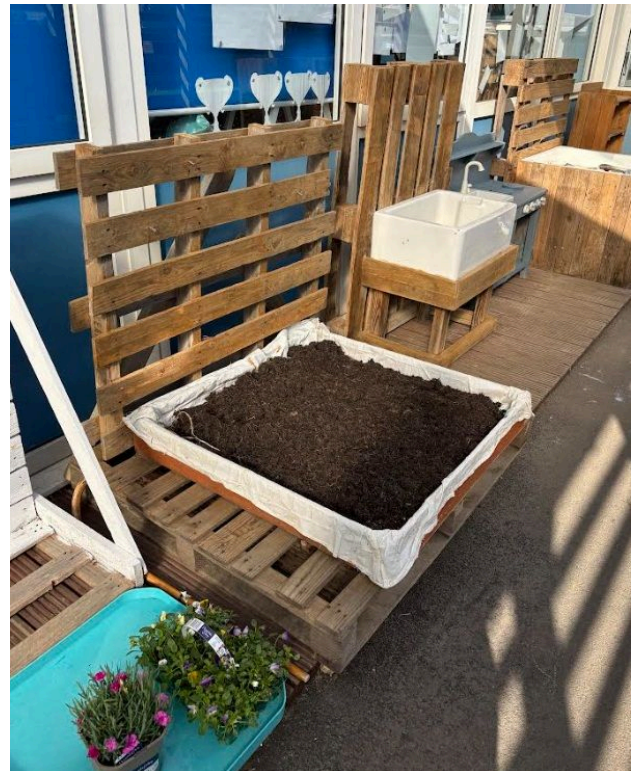

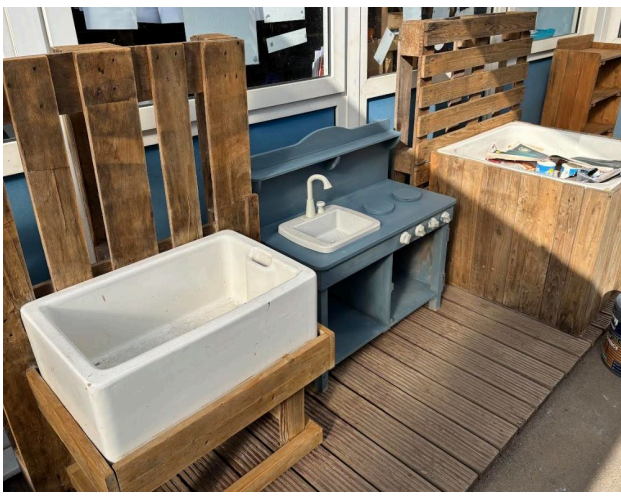
