EYFS News



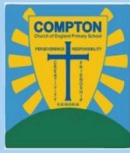

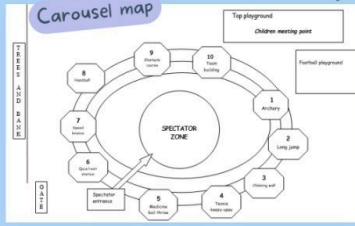
