On **Thursday 9th October**, one of our year 5 pupils, Max, will be holding a charity cake sale at 3:15pm in the school car park. Please read below why Max is supporting this very worthy cause.

Retina UK is a charity that means a lot to my family, it helps to research eye conditions like my Dad and Nan have. They have a genetic eye disease called Retinitis Pigmentosa. The condition causes peripheral sight loss and eventually blindness. My Nan is completely blind and has a guide dog but my Dad only has peripheral sight loss at the moment. There is also a 50% chance that I could also have the eye condition when I am older.

My Dad ran the London marathon for Retina UK and that inspired me to do my own fundraising for the charity. I have completed a 50 mile bike riding challenge and also a running challenge and raised over £500. I would like to continue to raise money for retina UK in hope that one day they will find a cure for some of these sight loss diseases. I am doing a cake sale after school on the 9th October so please support my stall to help me raise money for a good cause.

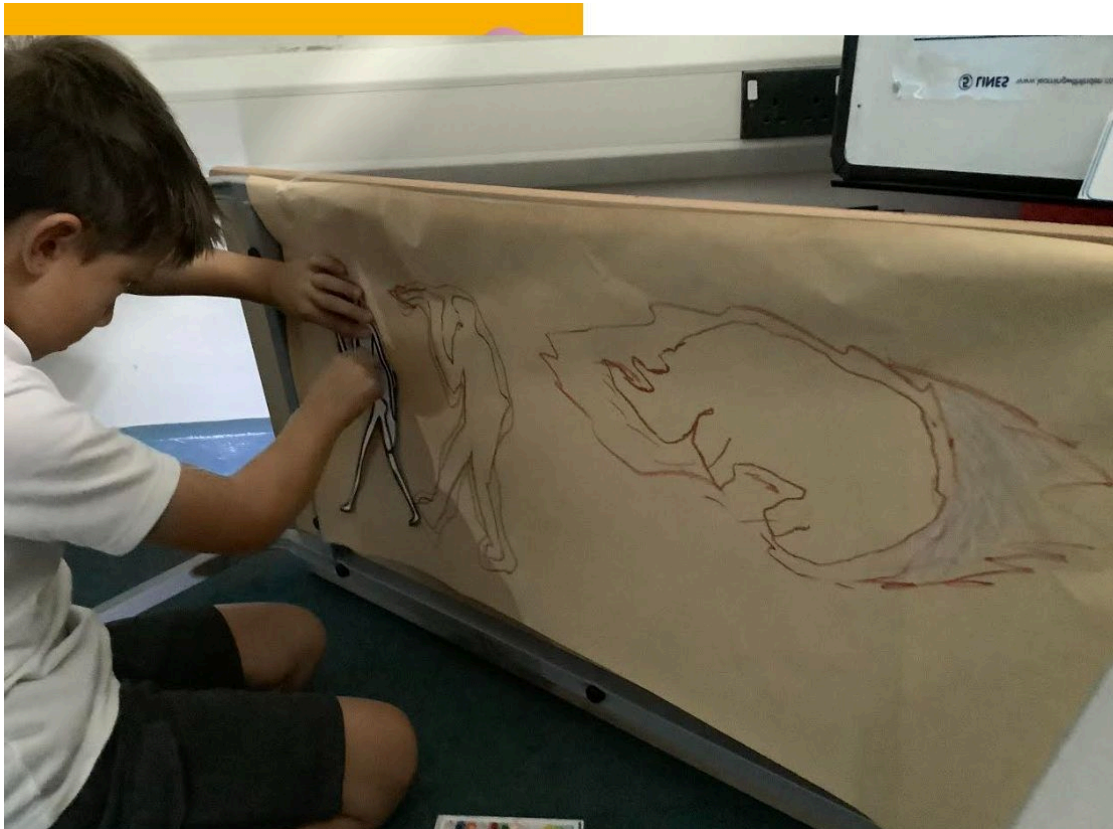

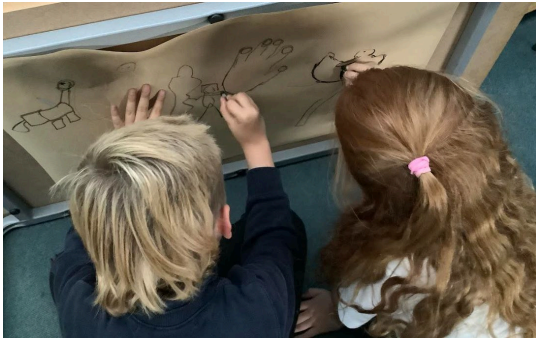
