### Our Mission Statement

### Aims and Objectives

Our policy on school uniform is based on the belief that we are pleased to wear a uniform that:

- Promotes a sense of pride in our school



- Helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- Identifies pupils with the school
- Supports the school's commitment to inclusion
- Is practical, smart, and designed with health and safety in mind
- Is considered to be good value for money

### **Jewellery, Hair Ornaments, Make-up and Nail Varnish**

For many reasons, including safety, we do not allow children to wear jewellery. The exceptions to this rule are earring studs in pierced ears (only a single piercing in the lower lobe).

A wrist watch can be worn, this does not include the wearing of a smart watch, this is not permitted.

Children are required to remove any items during P.E. lessons to prevent them from causing injury **or to stick a plaster over the stud during the lesson.**

Please note: Teachers are not permitted to remove earrings.

Long hair must be tied back. Hair bands, ribbons/bows or 'scrunchies' should be plain and either dark navy, dark grey or blue/white gingham to match our uniform. Hair bands should not have large flowers or other decorations attached.

Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school.

Extreme hairstyles are not appropriate for school. The use of styling products should be kept to a minimum and children should not have decorative patterns cut into their hair or have hair coloured or dyed.

### **Footwear**

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear shoes with platform soles or high heels. All children are required to wear plain black shoes without logos and no trainer shoes as stated in the uniform list. If boots are worn these should also be plain black.

As our Foundation children spend a lot of time outdoors, it is also important for all children to have a named pair of wellingtons to stay in school.

### **The Role of Parents/Carers**

We believe that one of the responsibilities of parents/carers is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, that it is clean, in good repair and that the child's name is visibly labelled on all items. If a parent/carer has difficulties for any reason with fulfilling this request they can speak to a senior member of staff or our parent Support Advisor, Lee Woodman to discuss the issues. Parents/carers should be assured that we will do all we can to help.

**Children who arrive at school wearing non-school uniform clothing will be loaned an appropriate item from our lost property to wear for that day if possible. The same system will apply for children who do not have a PE kit. Parents/carers will be contacted to discuss the matter.**



The school welcomes children from all backgrounds and faith communities. If there are serious reasons, for example on religious grounds, why parents/carers want their child to wear clothes that differ from the school uniform policy the school will consider such requests sympathetically. If any parent/carer would like to request an exception to the uniform policy they should, in the first instance, contact the Headteacher and then the Governors.

### **The Role of Governors**

The governing body supports the Headteacher in implementing the school uniform policy. It considers all representations from parents/carers regarding the uniform policy and liaises with the headteacher to ensure that the policy is implemented fairly and with sensitivity. It is the governors' responsibility to ensure that the school uniform meets all regulations concerning equal monitoring and review opportunities. Governors ensure that the school uniform policy enables children to dress sensibly, in clothing that is hard wearing, safe and practical.

### **Monitoring and Review**

The governing body will monitor and review the school uniform policy through its committee work by:

- seeking the views of parents/carers, to ensure that they agree with and support the policy;
- considering, with the headteacher, any requests from parents/carers for individual children to have special dispensation with regard to school uniform.

### **School Uniform List**

Compton's school uniform consists of:

- Dark Grey trousers/shorts
- Dark Grey pinafore, skirt, culottes
- Navy blue sweatshirt (with or without school logo)
- Navy blue sweatshirt cardigan (with or without the school logo), this can be knitted or a sweatshirt material
- White or navy blue polo shirt (with or without school logo)
- Grey, white, black socks or black/grey tights
- Black sensible shoes not a trainer style, no logo (no high heels)
- Summer dress (blue and white gingham)

### **PE and Games**

- Navy shorts
- Navy Jogging bottoms
- Yellow PE Shirt (with logo)
- Navy school jumper or cardigan (no brands or fleeces)
- Skorts (optional)
- Leggings (optional)
- Skins (optional and to be worn under PE top and bottoms, not instead of)



- Sensible trainers

### **Additional Items**

- Fleeces (outdoor wear only)
- Baseball caps or sun hats ( with or without our logo) during sunny playtimes
- Infants navy blue book bags (with logo)
