Dear Parents and Carers,

**Change to self-isolation rules:** If your child records a positive PCR test the original 10-day self-isolation period has been reduced to 7 days in most circumstances. Your child will need to take LFT tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation. Those who receive two negative test results and do not have a high temperature are no longer required to isolate and can return to school. Please note that anyone who is takes the LFT tests only will need to isolate for the full 10 days.

Any child in our setting who starts to show symptoms will be immediately isolated away from others and we will contact you to collect.

Public Health England have advised us that if your child has symptoms:

- New continuous cough and /or
- High temperature
- A loss, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell.

As we move into Spring we fully understand about the complications with the common cold and flu, but our advice will always be to get a PCR Test for peace of mind. If we all do this, we can ensure that we have all played a part in keeping the whole Compton Community safe.

We have a new electronic form to be completed if your child tests positive, this has been brought into place with the introduction of LFT testing as well.
